You will be expected to help find creative ways to maintain online communication with our audience and come up with methods to complete our marketing objectives through social media. In addition, the intern will be required to interact with our online community across our different platforms as well as engage with other organisations. Finally, the internship also includes keeping up with the various events and screenings held by UKJFF throughout the year in addition to the festival itself in November.
